Do you understand how the provisional measures deposit cap works? Do you have to deposit ADD/CVD on entries retroactively if there is a preliminary finding of critical circumstances? Can unfavorable scope rulings be applied to entries retroactively?

Antidumping duty and countervailing duty (ADD/CVD) compliance is a Priority Trade Issue for CBP. Importers are often hit with unexpected retroactive assessments, and in some case penalties, for errors in clearing ADD/CVD merchandise. False Claims Act cases have been initiated by whistleblowers for alleged ADD/CVD evasion. This webinar will explain the ADD/CVD process in simple terms that will allow importers, shippers, and brokers to effectively communicate as well as address common compliance concerns surrounding the processing of ADD/CVD entries for both the customs brokers processing the entries, and their importer clients.
