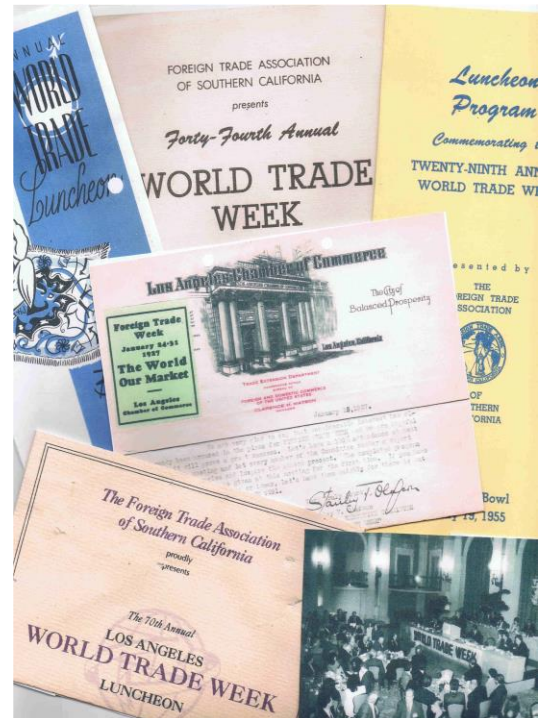

We welcome Ms. Angela Ellard, US House of Representatives, Ways & Means Committee Chief Trade Counsel, to share her insights on pending future and current trade legislation that may critically impact your business. She will discuss prominent trade issues including, but not limited to: the extension of the Generalized System of Preferences (GSP); consideration of the Miscellaneous Trade Bill (MTB); ongoing negotiations for the Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP), the Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership (TTIP), the Trade in International Services Agreement (TiSA), and the World Trade Organization; and recently introduced Bipartisan Congressional Trade Priorities Act (also known as Trade Promotion Authority), which would set the negotiating objectives, requirements for consultation by the Administration with Congress, and rules for Congressional consideration of legislation to implement trade agreements. This will be an OFF-THE-RECORD review of which way the political winds are drifting and the potential outcomes of the trade legislative and policy debate in the 113th Congress.

Angela Ellard is the Ways & Means Committee Chief Trade Counsel and Trade Subcommittee Staff Director in the U.S. House of Representatives. She advises Chairman Dave Camp (R-MI), Subcommittee Chairman Devin Nunes (R-CA), and the other Members on a variety of trade matters, including negotiations and implementation of bilateral and regional free trade agreements, the operation of U.S. trade laws, trade promotion authority, antidumping and countervailing duty issues, bilateral relationships with U.S. trading partners, preference programs for developing countries, and World Trade Organization negotiations and dispute settlement. Before joining the Committee staff in 1995, Ms. Ellard was in private practice, specializing in international trade litigation and policy. Ms. Ellard received her J.D. from Tulane Law School, cum laude, where she was an associate editor of the Tulane Law Review. She holds a Master of Arts degree in Public Policy from Tulane University and a Bachelor of Arts degree from Newcomb College of Tulane University, summa cum laude. She has won awards from the American Bar Association, the Washington International Trade Association, and the Organization of Women in International Trade.
