ACE for Importers

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Customs just gave the trade community a brief reprieve on the mandatory dates for filing entries in ACE. Some entries will become mandatory at the end of March, some at the end of May and some this summer. Along with these new mandatory use dates Customs and other government agencies are making a number of other ACE changes. This program will review the transition to ACE and how to minimize any disruptions it may cause to your import operations. Specific topics will include-

- Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service Lacey Act entries in ACE
