You can purchase the HTSUS and Customs Regulations from either of two sources. Boskage Commerce Publications (a Thomson Reuters company) www.boskage.com offers the HTSUS, Customs Regulations and additional materials and guarantees the correct editions for all students who purchase their Required Testing Material Packages (or individual books for specific exams). (Note: be sure to purchase the editions specific to the exam for which you are planning to study.) Boskage sells both the HTSUS and the Customs Regulations in loose-leaf versions that include binders and convenient tabs.
